There are two themes for photographs – whichever you choose, they should show aspects of disabled people's lives in Norfolk:

- 1. 'Life Out and About' examples might be images showing: working life/employment, sports, transport, days out, eating out/social events, people using public spaces, the work of clubs and organizations.
- 2. 'Life in the Home' examples might be: domestic tasks, pets and working animals, home technology and adaptions, interiors and hobbies.
